



BLUE MOUNTAINS CLASSIC TOURNAMENT RULES

Division 1 – 1 JPL + 1 Rep, 3 Reps (no JPL) or no reps

Division 2 – No JPL Players – maximum 2 Rep Players

NOTE: Development Players are considered Rep Players

All player status will be cross checked against BNSW database.

Games

15 min halves,

2 min half time,

2 x 30 sec time out – clock stops

Last 1 minute fully timed – clock stops on whistle unless difference of 15 or more,
time out ball advance on request

Semis & Finals

2 x 60 sec time out – clock stops

Last 2 minutes fully timed – time out ball advance on request

If finals games are drawn at full- time, overtime of 5 minutes – foul count stays, extra time out

FIBA Standard Rules apply except as listed below

Mercy Rule – 20 point difference – players move back behind the 3 point line until the ball is over halfway

Every player must take the court in every game – an exception may be made for injury provided email notification is received prior to the game, advising that the player is not able to take the court.

u12 & u14s no Zone defence – BNSW Rep Rule

Uniforms – under garments must be black or white, knee or elbow sleeves must be black or white, teams must all wear the same singlets, shorts that match the singlet or plain black NO POCKETS

TECHNICAL or UNSPORTSMANLIKE FOULS

If a player receives a Tech Foul or Unsportsmanlike Foul – the player leaves the court for 3 minutes and no substitution is allowed. If a player receives 2 of the same foul or 1 of each, that player is out for the remainder of the game, and the team will continue to play with 4 players.

If a player receives 3 Tech Fouls within the tournament, the player is eliminated and not able to play any further games in the tournament, including semis and finals.

If the Bench or Coach receive a Tech, a player is to be taken off the court for 3 minutes and the team will play with only 4 players for the 3 minutes.

SPECTATORS – ZERO TOLERANCE

Basketball NSW Code of Conduct applies

Poor or unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated by the tournament officials.

Spectators and other participants must not:

Use derogatory language based on gender, race, ability or impairment. (All participants are expected to actively support all efforts to remove all forms of verbal abuse such as sledging or trash-talk from our sporting environment) Direct any offensive, hostile or negative comments to any opposition coaches, players, referees or spectators. Any references designed to 'bait' opposition players, coaches, referees or spectators is strictly prohibited

Abuse of referees will not be tolerated – they are also someone's child regardless of their age, you don't want your child abused, don't abuse other peoples.

Spectators will receive one (1) warning then will be asked to leave the stadium for remainder of game.

If a spectator is asked to leave the stadium twice, they will not be permitted to return for the remainder of the tournament.
